## **Statco Engineering Disclosure in Compliance with California Transparency in Supply Chains Act of 2010 (SB657)**

This disclosure is designed to provide information to consumers, allowing them to make informed decisions about the products they buy and companies they support. Retailers and manufacturers, doing business in the state of California, and of a certain size, are required to disclose the measures taken to track the possibility of human trafficking, forced labor, and slavery in their supply chains.

Statco Engineering strives to always conduct business in a moral and legal manner. For these reasons, Statco does not knowingly support businesses that may allow this to occur within their own supply chain.

Reviews to Statco Engineering procedures and programs occur on an ongoing basis to ensure that amendments and adjustments are made as necessary, to cover the specific topics covered in the law.

### **Verification**

Statco Engineering does not require certifications from our vendors/partners that they are free of human trafficking, forced labor, and slavery in their own supply chains. Statco expects that all vendors/partners, and their supply chains, comply with human trafficking, forced labor, and slavery, both legally and morally, in the countries in which they, or their supply chains, do business.

### **Auditing**

Statco Engineering does not perform supply chain audits of their suppliers, but does require vendor/partners to adhere to Statco's standards of moral and legal business practices, regardless of where in their global supply chain the items or service is sourced.

### **Certification**

Statco Engineering does not have a supplier certification process pertaining to human trafficking, forced labor, or slavery. If it becomes known that a potential, or current supplier, knowingly or unknowingly utilizes human trafficking, forced labor, or slavery in the course of their business operations, Statco's board of directors will determine if the relationship will be severed, or if other improvements can be made to rectify the situation in order to retain or reinstate the relationship.
